Membership Categories and Dues for NAESP and HEMSAA

Active, \$349 – Practicing elementary and middle-level principals and related educators receive all NAESP benefits & services including the Legal Benefits Program (<i>\$2 million individual professional liability coverage and up to \$10,000 of liability coverage for job protection defense, based on continuous years of membership</i>), access to webinars, podcasts, research, online learning, discounts on ASCA+ membership, conference registration, resources, etc.
Institutional Active, \$399 – Includes all benefits of an Active membership plus a duplicate set of publications for your school or office library.

Associate, \$249 – Available to professors of education or non-administrators. Includes most NAESP benefits and services. Includes all NAESP benefits and services EXCEPT the Legal Benefits Program.
